



Why Tithe? Tithing is a way to worship God—to honor Him as your provider and remind yourself that all of your resources belong to Him and are provided through His grace.

When Should I Give? Consider your pay schedule, and establish a pattern of giving when your resources increase.

Where Should I Give? Typically, the tithe should be given to the local church where you worship. These gifts support your pastor and ministry staff members who are actively serving you, and they help maintain the work of the church in your community.

What Should I Give? The tithe is 10% of your gross income. In addition to giving 10% of your monetary income, consider giving God the firstfruits of other resources as well, such as your time and energies.
